The School history

In 1997 Mohamed El Kabany and his wife Ingrid have decided to establish a school with the intention of providing their daughter a good schooling and solving a community problem by offering a better quality of education for its children, as there has always been a lack of a proper one in the small city of Dahab.

However they had immense difficulties in attaining the school licence from the Governor, as it was the pioneer first ever private school in South Sinai. It took them a record of three months working day and night to construct the building.

Everything was ready September 97. The teaching has started, plain and simple, with a girl and two teachers although they had to wait for the Governors approval for three months.

Officially the school was opened with 8 children on December 17th 1997 in a ceremony attended by the Governor of South Sinai.

Over the years more and more children joined the school. The building got higher; more teachers were employed to match the number of students. Today it holds about 150 students and offers an education to children of different nationalities starting from kindergarten to the end of preparatory stage.
